
Recap Around Andersonville Island (Alone) (or not)

To quote Cowardly Lion from The Wizard of Oz, "Unusual weather we're having, ain't it?". Weather was a big factor in this year's "Round the Island' race. What began as the usual concern for way too-much heat and probably way too-little wind became the unusual concern for too much wind. The National Weather Service forecast for Saturday looked like this:





At the skipper's meeting, a number of entrants withdrew from the race. As boats left the harbor after the skipper's meeting, the wind was WSW about 13-16. It seemed to increase a little while we waited for the fleet to assemble at S 19 for the start of the delay time clock. One boat retired before her start. One boat retired shortly after her start with rigging failure.

As this was a pursuit start race, boats started at different times. Delay time ranged from 1 minute (San Juan 21) to 20 minutes and 12 seconds (Hobie 18). Almost all boats that had the ability to reef the mainsail did so. The majority of the fleet chose to round the island clockwise, and most also chose to sail through the 'cut' at the

southern end of Andersonville Island. With the length of the race course being 7.5 miles, there was quite a bit of separation by the end of the race. The wind strength seemed to suit the multihulls; three (of four) were the first boats to finish. The first two monohulls crossed the finish line separated by only 18 seconds. Exciting! Other than the boat retiring with rigging failure, all boats that started were able to finish within the time limit. And it's good that they did because....



With the last boat finishing, a storm cell was fast approaching. My hand-held anemometer displayed a steady 18 mph. As the last boat motored into the harbor, very heavy rain could be seen coming across the lake. Race committee docked the signal boat in the downpour.

Not to worry, because as the signal boat was docking, the skippers and crews were gathered in the clubhouse, enjoying beverages and Nancy-Sue Harder's snack buffet. There was even a luscious chocolate birthday cake for one of the event organizers ["...Will you still need me, will you still feed me, when I'm..." (Beatles-Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band-)].
