Rules: The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013-2016 and prescriptions of US Sailing, applicable class rules, this notice and the Sailing Instructions. The regatta is classified as Category A. Measurement certificates will not be required.

Entry: The regatta is open to all sailboats. We will have a Distance Race Course, Day Sailors, and Juniors. PHRF and Centerboard boats will be scored separately. Each sailboat on the distance course must have a female at the helm throughout the duration of each race. Day Sailors must have a female aboard either helping to sail or learning to sail. Entrants must complete registration with Western Carolina Sailing Club (WCSC), the organizing authority, to be eligible to compete.

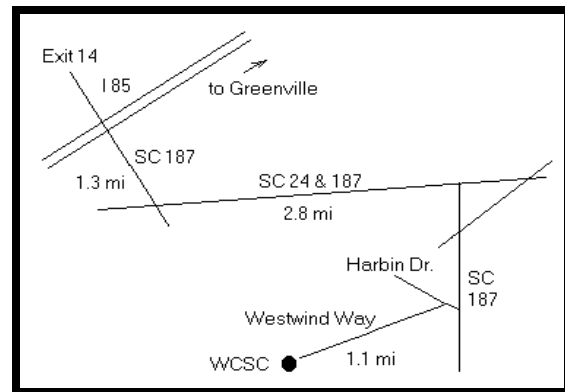
